Cybersecurity... Are you Protected?

You may have heard the term "WannaCry" in the news lately. WannaCry is the name of a recently released malware that successfully infected over 200,000 computers across the world. At First Metro Bank, our goal is to protect our neighbors and their information. Please consider the following information to keep yourself safe online.

WannaCry was a type of malware called "ransomware." This means that once a computer is infected, the malicious software begins encrypting, or locking up, all of the files on the machine. The criminals spreading the malware then demand payment to release the key necessary to unlock those files. Victims of such an attack can either pay the ransom, or lose the files that were locked.

The effects of an attack like this can be truly devastating. The following tips can help you prevent or recover from a ransomware infection:

- 1. Think Before You Click. Most cyber attacks start through a "phishing" email. This is an email containing a malicious link or attachment. Be absolutely sure every email you receive is legitimate before clicking any links or downloading any attachments.
- 2. Patch Your Devices. Always apply the latest security patches available for any internet-connected device you use. A patch to fix the vulnerability exploited by WannaCry had been available for almost two months before WannaCry was released. Computers that were fully patched were never at risk.
- 3. Backup Your Data. If your computer is ever infected with ransomware, having a recent backup of your data means you don't have to pay the ransom, and all of your files are safe. There are several cloud-based (internet) services that are convenient and affordable, but a local external drive will also work.
