# Be Aware of SOCIAL **MEDIA SCAMS!**

While social media is a great way to communicate, share, and stay connected with others, it is also a low-cost way for cyber criminals to trick and take advantage of millions of people. Do not fall victim to these two common scams on social media.

# ONLINE SHOPPING SCAMS

Tempting ads on social media will often promote great prices and provide links to sites that appear to be legitimate. You complete your purchase only to never receive your item and, when it is too late, realize you have been scammed. Be wary of sites that have no contact information or personal email addresses. It is also smart to research reviews on the company before making a first-time purchase.

## **ROMANCE SCAMS**

Cyber criminals often search for lonely or vulnerable individuals that they can build an online relationship with and then trick them out of money. Romance scams are more common than you think and these criminals will use whatever tactics necessary such as sending photos or buying gifts. They will then come up with a tragic story about needing money in order to travel to see the victim to coerce them into paying for travel expenses or other needs. Money is often requested through wire transfers or gift cards. These scams are common on social media as well as online dating sites.
