#### SMISHING RED FLAGS

Smishing (a word combining SMS and phishing) are attacks that occur when cyber attackers use text messaging to trick you into taking actions you should not take. Criminals often play on your emotions to get you to act by creating a sense of urgency or curiosity. Here are a few questions to ask yourself to spot the most common clues of a smishing attack.

- Does the message create a sense of urgency to rush or pressure you?
- Is the offer too good to be true?
- Is the message taking you to websites that ask for personal information?
- Does the message look like the equivalent of a wrong number?
- Does the linked website force you to pay using non-standard methods such as bitcoin, gift cards, or western union transfers?
