

Out With The Old, In With The New

How to securely dispose of your old mobile devices

Mobile devices, such as smartphones, smart watches, and tablets, continue to advance and innovate at an astonishing rate. Unfortunately, people often do not realize how much personal data is on these devices when they get ready to upgrade to a newer device. The personal data stored on your device may include:

- · Where you live, work, and places you visit
- · The contact information for everyone in your address book
- · Phone call history
- Texting or chat sessions
- · Web browsing history and search history
- · Personal photos, videos, and audio recordings
- Stored passwords and access to your personal accounts
- · Health related information

Regardless of how you dispose of your mobile device, you need to be sure you first erase all sensitive information. Simply deleting data is not enough, instead you should securely erase all the data on your device. The easiest way to do this is to reset your device. Finally, we highly recommend you backup your device before resetting it.

Also, be sure to remove any SIM (Subscriber Identity Module) cards or external data cards from your old device. If you are keeping your current phone number and moving to a new device, talk to your phone service provider about transferring your SIM card, otherwise you should destroy the SIM card or external data card to prevent someone from retrieving your personal information that is stored on it.
