

IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION



Identity theft occurs when someone steals your identity to commit fraud. Stealing your identity could mean using personal information without your permission, such as stealing your name, Social Security Number, bank account information, or credit card number. Here are a few steps to help protect you from identity theft:

Secure your Social Security Number (SSN)

Only provide your SSN when absolutely necessary.

Don't share personal information

Don't share your birthdate, SSN, or bank account number just because someone asks for it.

Review your credit card and bank account statements

Watch for unauthorized transactions.

Review your credit report once a year

Be certain that the report doesn't include accounts that you have not opened. You can order your report for free once a year from annualcreditreport.com.
