Almost every home network starts with a wireless (or Wi-Fi) network. This is what enables your devices to connect to the Internet. Most home wireless networks are controlled by your Internet router or a separate, dedicated wireless access point. They both work by broadcasting wireless signals which allow the devices in your house to connect to the Internet.

Securing your wireless network is a key part of protecting your house. The following steps are recommended when building a cyber secure home:

- Change the default administrator password to your Internet router or wireless access point.
- Ensure that only devices you trust can connect to your wireless network. Doing so requires a password to connect to your home network and encrypts online activities once connected.
- Ensure the password used to connect to your wireless network is a strong password that is different from the administrator password.
